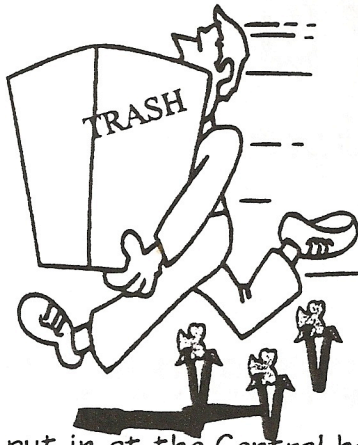
Welcome New Fish!!

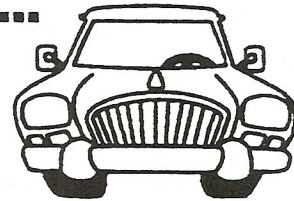
Spring Cleanup

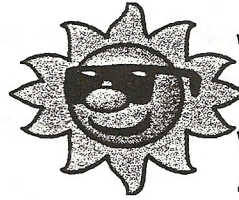
