Incorporation?

As summer slowly approaches, I feel it is important as the new Chairman of the Forest Lake Community Association (FLCA) to inform all homeowners in Forest Lake that potential changes to land use in areas adjacent to our subdivision are approaching rapidly.

These potential changes may permanently alter our status as an independent and unincorporated community. These changes would also bring substantially higher property taxes, and a loss of control over our own destiny.

It is with this issue in mind that I appeal to the residents of Forest Lake, as well as those owners who rent their homes in Forest Lake, not only to regularly attend our association board meetings at 7:30 pm on the second Tuesday of each month, but to strongly consider current payment of your association dues as soon as possible if they are not paid already.

The regular payment of dues to the FLCA provides residents with many benefits: A beautiful and clean lake with a high quality fishery, a well-appointed community center available for rental, several well maintained parks and beaches, and family-oriented events such as the Easter Egg Hunt, the Halloween Party, and Breakfast with Santa.

In addition, the defense of our rights as a community, and to keep our taxes low, is only going to be possible through the retention of superior legal counsel. This costs money as well, and a community unified in the defense of its rights stands the best chance of success.

In closing, I would say that everything the FLCA has worked for in support of, and in service to, its residents is at risk. Your involvement at meetings and your commitment to support your community through payment of dues has never been more important than it is today.
