# Incorporation?

A meeting was held on Wednesday, July 14 to begin investigating the option of incorporating Forest Lake as a village. Approximately 100 members of our community met with municipal consultant, Laurie Marston, who has 30 years of experience in this field. She was hired by the Association to study various incorporation alternatives. The meeting began by Laurie asking for comments about what we like living in Forest Lake and things that we don't like about living here. This was followed by, "What would we like to change?" The 17-page report details what it will take to become a village, the advantages and disadvantages, possible budget, property tax rate, recommendation, and next steps for the community. All registered voters in Forest Lake will have the opportunity vote in a general election to decide on the incorporation issue.

Laurie Marston's findings were discussed at the August 10 Meeting. Becoming the "Village of Forest Lake" is a viable option. The board will look further into budget estimates for supplying services, escrow accounts and additional details involved in becoming a village. Most residents enjoy living in Forest Lake and would like it to retain its current lifestyle.

reproduce and spread unwanted species into our lake and all streams, rivers and lakes that Forest Lake connects to.

#### Sand Beaches

Your community association provides 3 excellent sand beaches. Please do not build your own beach and dump sand along the edge of the lake. During periods of heavy rain, the sand will wash away and fill in the lake. The shoreline should consist of natural shoreline plantings, stone or broken concrete something that will not wash away.

#### Venetian Night

Forest Lake's Annual Venetian Night will be held on the Sunday, September 5. Decorate your boat and join others at dusk (7:30pm) and circle the lake. If you don't have a boat, come down to the lake and cheer the boats on. Your favorite beverage is encouraged. The rain date is Monday, Labor Day.

#### FYI

It is against the law to feed wildlife other than birds. Please do not feed raccoons, opossums, squirrels, chipmunks, deer or other wildlife. It not only attracts them to your yard but to your neighbors' yards and can cause problems.

#### **Beaches Not Closed**

Closed signs were accidently put on the beaches earlier this month due to an algae bloom. After additional research, it was learned that it is not necessary to close the beaches when this occurs. It is a natural occurrence in the summer when the water warms up and there is no wind or rain to mix the surface. Phosphate fertilizers are also a contributing factor. Therefore we remind everyone if using fertilizers please use non-phosphate types.

It is advisable to shower after swimming in the lake and never drink the water.
