## Annual Dues

By now everyone should have received their annual dues notices in the mail. As you'll see, the Board has elected not to raise the dues this coming year. Yearly dues will remain at \$150, which includes one car sticker. Additional stickers are \$1.00 and boat stickers are \$25. If you pay your dues by January 1, there is a \$10 discount. While we realize these economic times are tough for many, the dues are our only source of income and are used for upkeep of the lake, beaches, parks and community center. Spearheaded by Nick Leonard and assisted by willing volunteers, Erker Park is sporting a brand-new waterfront deck. The old, warping wood was replaced and the shoreline was rehabilitated and stabilized with riprap and cobble over highquality fabric, to limit erosion. Yellow flag irises were donated and planted along the shoreline to add color and further help stabilization. Removal of the invasive buckthorn will be completed by the end of the year. A follow-up project is being planned to address the erosion issues on the south side of the park. Volunteers for this project included Nick Leonard, Greg Dwiel, Steve McDowell, Scott Kretsmeir, Rich McCullough, Aaron Towne and Steve Libby. Plants were donated by Frank McCoy and planted by Maija Boriss and Scott Kretsmeir (who just happened to be at the park). A big THANK YOU to everyone who helped on this project.

The construction that you have been seeing at Melody Lane and Old McHenry Road is to connect 76 properties in Forest Lake to the Aqua Illinois well in Hawthorn Woods. Most of these properties are currently on a private well that the county owns and maintains. The county cannot meet the new regulations from the State of Illinois and is shifting the responsibility of maintaining the water standards to Aqua Illinois. Owners of all properties involved have been notified and are aware of this change.

## Help Mark the Roads

This is especially helpful during major snowstorms like last year's blizzard. Also, if your dog drops something on the ice, it will eventually end up in the water where we swim. It does not go away on its own.
