  - The aerator in the lagoon has been upgraded to better match our goals. The aerator at Erker Park was also activated inadvertently and will be shut off.

  - We are still working on removal of curly-leaf pond weed and need lots of volunteers. Any plants left in the lake will contribute to a blue-green algae outbreak in the summer. Five special rakes have been purchased and are available for use to remove plants from the lake.

- Inlet testing continues. Lake County is investigating a problem upstream from inlet #1 (the former Pugsley & LaHaie Property), but will not yet disclose the nature of the problem.
- A couple more private shorelines have been restored. Approximately six are being re-done this year. Contact Nick for advice if you want to restore your shoreline.
- We are still looking into the duck-weed problem (from upstream, across Quentin), but without rain it hasn't been a problem this year.

  - Tree trimming has been completed at all the parks
  - The footpaths have all been cleared and will be continually maintained.
  - The ballfield has been prepped.
  - Sand has been added to the beaches.
  - Playground mulch will be donated by McGinty Bros.
  - The trash can is missing from Steinken Park. Will contact Waste Management.
  - The goose line has been replaced at Central Park and Luttrell Park.

  - Some weeding has been done. Will have Winkleman do more.
  - Will plant new stuff at Highland since the late-season annuals aren't yet blooming.
