Recognizing our Lake Committee

To recognize Frank Loftus' tireless volunteer stewardship efforts and to provide local lake communities and lake users the opportunity to recognize local stewardship, in 2002 the Illinois Lakes Management Association membership established the Frank Loftus Conservation Award. Our lake committee was awarded this prestigious award in 2014.

Our Lake Committee is responsible for improving the quality of our lake and shoreline. Over the past several years, portions of inlets have been restored and, due to a vigorous stocking program, Forest Lake has a diverse fish community that offers a variety of recreational opportunities.

In 2014 our Lake Committee was awarded the prestigious Frank Loftus Award, which is given in recognition of lake stewardship and improvement. Since its inception, Nick Leonard has headed the committee, assisted by Larry Steker and Joe Wachter, the VLMP team committed to collecting quality data. Greg Ratliff is responsible for collecting and taking samples to the IEPA lab. Lou Dinicola has a passion for fisheries and his primary contribution to Forest Lake is overseeing the stocking program. He truly cares for these fish, as he carefully monitors the fish deliveries to minimize the stress the fish go through adapting to their new home. Todd Thomas hosts the meetings where this work group gets together to discuss the goals, outcomes, and tasks to improve Forest Lake.

Nick keeps the group focused on treating the lake problems, not the symptoms. This group has been so successful because they communicate with each other, divide the tasks, and share a love of lakes. Our thanks to each member of this committee for their dedication and time spent for our community.

1 Walleye Pike - 18"

1 Northern Pike - 18"

1 Muskellunge - 36"

3 Bass - 14"

10 Panfish -

3 Catfish

Carp – No limit - Please do not release back into the lake.
