Our Annual Warning!

The lake will freeze soon and it will be tempting to go out and enjoy it. Be careful and check the thickness of the ice, as the thickness varies from one location to another. Just because you see someone out on the ice, don't assume that it is thick enough. Drill a hole in the ice. It should be 4 inches thick for small groups. Once the ice is 5 or 6 inches thick, enjoy the lake. Ice fishing, skating, cross country skiing, walking and other activities are to be enjoyed.
