Wear Bright Colors at Night for Safety

Boy, is our neighborhood dark at night—there's not a lot of street lighting. While walking at night, stay alert of your surroundings. If you are driving, please drive within the speed limit and be alert!

Thin Ice

With winter approaching, please be cautious when going onto the ice. For the ice to be safe, it should be at last 6" thick. The thickness can be checked by drilling a hole in the ice with a portable drill. Please be aware that some areas may be thinner than others. Snowmobilers who are members, or are accompanied by members, may ride on the lake

when the ice is at least 8" thick. Hours for snowmobiling are 8 am to 10 pm.

Zoning Violations

If you notice uncut grass, garbage in yard, building without a permit or other neighborhood nuisances please be neighborly and try to resolve with your neighbor as a first step. Sometimes it can be resolved very quickly and you might make a new friend in the process. Let's keep Forest Lake friendly! If an issue remains unresolved, contact Lake County at 847-377-2600. Annual Dues

It is that time of year, annual dues notices will soon be in the mail. Yearly dues for 2017 will be at \$180.00, which includes one car sticker. Additional stickers are \$1.00 and boat stickers are \$25, boat launch keys are \$5 each. While we realize these economic times are tough for many, the dues are our only source of income and are used for upkeep of the lake, beaches, parks and community center. It also helps fund the great events around the neighborhood for the kids: the aforementioned Halloween Parade, Breakfast with Santa, and the Easter Egg Hunt. Most condominium dues are \$150 a month or higher. If you do not receive an invoice in the mail, contact Greg Dwiel chair@flcaonline.org.
