The kit includes a sealed water sample bottle, laboratory form and instructions for taking the sample. Thank you to everyone who attended our 2nd Annual Kids Movie Night! It was a super fun night enjoyed by all



your driving habits.

My brother and his family recently moved to Chippewa Falls, WI where one of these tragedies occurred. My niece's teacher lost her daughter in the accident that killed three Girl Scouts and the mom of one of those Girl Scouts. Another Girl Scout was severely injured as well. All five victims were picking up trash on the side of a road when they were hit. That community is devastated by this horrific and heartbreaking loss.

So many accidents can be avoided by slowing down and paying attention (get off the phone!). Keep in mind that we don't have sidewalks and there are children, adults and pets on our streets every single day. The 25 MPH Speed Limit is too fast to begin with and careless and disrespectful drivers are driving well above it. Be considerate of your neighbors and other residents. The few seconds you think you'll save by speeding could seriously injure or kill someone. Is it worth it?
